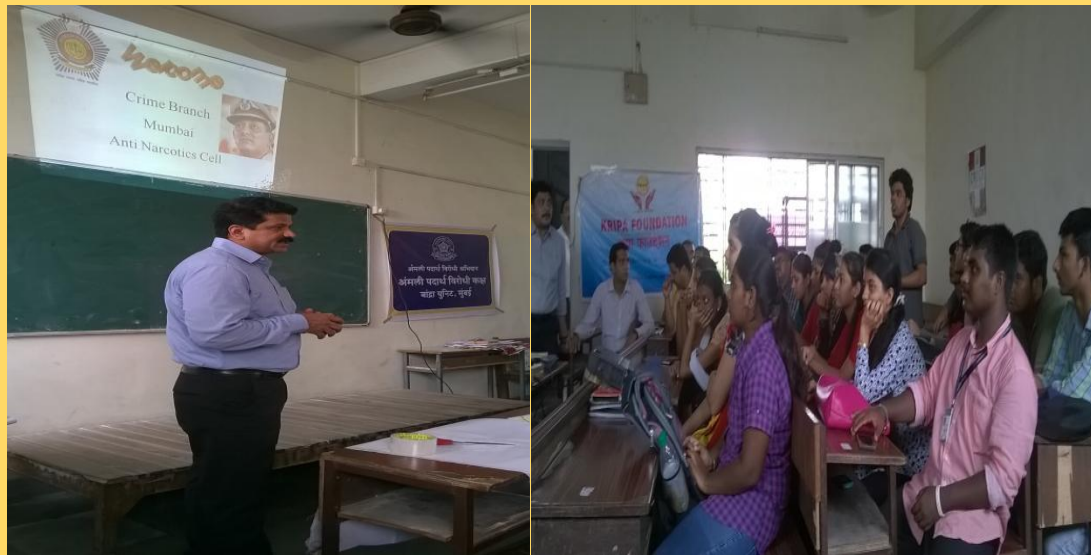
## *Essay Writing Competition On HIV Aids On 2<sup>nd</sup> December 2015*
