13. Best practices

Best Practice 1: Book Review Presentation and Library Period

Objectives of the Practice

Book Review Presentation

The reading culture among the students are diminishing in the current digital era, where digital distractions has replaced the reading habit. Reading improves one's vocabulary, memory and knowledge. Objective here was to promote reading habit among teachers and students. This practice was introduced among teachers first, but with the teachers motivating the students, the number of students coming to review books increased.

Library Period

Objective was to promote usage of library resources. It was seen that only few students use reference books for their study purpose, either they issue textbooks only or come to library to complete notes and study. This practice makes the student come to library along with their teacher and check the books, e-resources and other resources available subject wise. Thus they become accustomed to their subject collection and become interested in use of library.

The Context

Book Review Presentation

The thing that was to be kept in mind was that it should not affect the lectures of students and teachers as 30 - 45 mints of lecture time is used up , also the decorum of library as book review is held in library with other readers present in library.

Library Period

The number of students that could be accommodated in library when students who come for library period are in full capacity along with the regular readers was a challenging issue to maintain the decorum of library. Space constraint.

The Practice

Book Review Presentation

This presentation is organized in collaboration with English Department. The notice regarding the book review presentation is circulated and flyer is displayed on notice board. Those interested are required to give names and date on which they will present beforehand. The presentation is kept for half an hour to 45 mints. Each participant is given 5 to 7 mints to speak. The English Department teachers are asked to judge the presentations, they give their inputs about the presentation given and gives ideas to improve the presentation. The readers are guided by the librarian as to how to present the review; given wide choice of books from the library, E-books available on Google books and other free websites. The books they have to choose is general reading books, inspirational books any book other than their regular subject books.

Library Period

A notice is circulated among teachers to take library period. Here teachers are required to take appointed time from the Librarian, so that two classes time in library do not clash. The teachers bring their whole class to the library and show them the reference books available in their respective subjects and in which section of library it is available. Library staff help the teachers in taking out books for the students. Use of other library resources to get information is also explained and shown practically. Also students are encouraged to read newspapers, magazines and take part in various library activities.

Evidence of Success

In 2022-23 only 7 teachers had given book review presentation. With motivation in 2023-24 the presenters increased to 48 students and teachers. This shows the interest the students and teachers are taking. The students are asked to suggest books they want in library and for book review. These books are bought by the library. The students keep on coming for more books to read as a result of book review. Their fear of facing the crowd has also diminished, an improvement in confidence level is seen among students.

Since Library period was introduced teachers and students have taken keen interest in visiting library and referring to the subject books. The footfall increases with such best practice. In 2022-23, from 16 teachers who took library period, the number has increased to 30 teachers.

The introduction of these best practices has increased the interest of teachers and students in giving book reviews and more students are suggesting and issuing books other than their study books. The footfall of library has also increased. The library also felicitates those who have given book reviews on Library appreciation day to motivate teachers and students.

Problems Encountered

Book Review Presentation

Due to their other academic commitments and lectures, teachers find it difficult to get time to come for presentations. Students need more coaxing to participate. Distractions like time spent on social media deter them to take out time for reading, fear of presenting in front of others is also a factor of not coming forth.

For Library period the problem we face is lack of separate space to take these sessions, because as we have only one reading room, other readers have to be told to move out to accommodate the library period class. Also teachers can't speak out loudly to address the students due to other students studying in the library.

Note:

All the colleges should start this best practice to bring students to attract students to the library. The support of Principal and teachers play a key part in implementing this best practice. The librarian need to be pro-active and ensure

that students and teachers interest do not diminish and also appreciate the effort of those following the best practice. Creating well-read individuals benefits the future of the whole academic community and boost their self - confidence and helps in career success.

Best Practice 2: “Saquib Rizvi Memorial Cancer Awareness Marathon”

Objectives of the Practice

The marathon aimed to raise funds to support and motivate cancer survivors, and educate the community about the importance of early detection and prevention.
