
1. PPT -Competition on World Energy Conservation day




3. "Seminar on world Cancer day": 4th Feb' 2021

The Event was Co-ordinated by Dr. ranade – Head dept of Physics and omline co-ordination is done by Prof. Vishwas Deshmukh.




Event 2: Debate Competition 05/03/2021

The event was co=ordinated by Dr. Ranade – head dept of Physics and Online management done by Prof,. Vishwas Deshmukh.








5. "Workshop on cracking of UPSC and MPSC Examination" 3rd April 2021
